Radio Update

The board members at Good Shepherd Catholic Radio wish each of you a very Blessed and Happy New Year!

We enter 2013 with a great deal of excitement and anticipation and we want to share with you some of our key activities during the past year:

January

• We finalized a letter of intent with EWTN, to become their broadcasting affiliate (Ave Maria is also an affiliate of EWTN)

• Began our third year of broadcasting an hour of Catholic radio each Saturday, from WLCM, a Christian broadcasting station located in Charlotte

- Opened negotiations to purchase a small radio station located in Jackson
- Jackson Lansing Catholic Radio took on a full Catholic identity, by becoming Good Shepherd Catholic Radio.

• We were privileged to again, meet with Bishop Boyea to discuss our progress. **February**

• Ash Wednesday, February 22nd, the paperwork for the purchase of the Jackson station reached the desk of the Federal Communication Commission, in Washington D.C.

June

• Sadly, the above purchase agreement was negated by the FCC

July – August

• We immediately began a search for another station, and in July, began discussions with a station currently serving Lansing; those conversations lasted through August. **October – Current**

• In October we were very fortunate to welcome Kathy Schmaltz as a member of our Board of Directors. Many of you know Kathy from her active involvement in both the Lansing and Jackson area. After reading her brief biography, which is included in this newsletter, I am sure that you will be as pleased as we are to have Kathy as a member of our board.

• After returning from the EWTN Catholic Radio Conference, held in Birmingham Al., we entered into serious negotiations for stations that will serve both Lansing and Jackson; those conversations are ongoing and will be a major part of my upcoming meeting with Bishop Boyea. You will also be pleased to know that during the past year, there were 30 new Catholic Radio stations that began broadcasting in the U.S. That brings the current national number of stations to 228.

She is associated with the Lumen Christi Auction Committee, Wendy's LPGA Charity Classic for Adoption, Trustee with the Purple Rose Theater, State Board of Easter Seals, and chair of the Grand Slam for Kids with United Way. She was appointed by Governor John Engler, to the Michigan Education Trust Board and the Michigan

Hospital Finance Board, and was named Jackson Distinguished Citizen of the year in 2006. Kathy and her family are members of Queen of the Miraculous Medal Parish in Jackson.
