ANNUAL FUNDRAISING ACTIVITY

The GSCR Annual Year-End Appeal was a success, but overall donations for 2022 were down by 30% from the prior year. The Spring and Fall On-Air Fundraisers, as well as the ongoing monthly donations, reflected the economic situation of the Jackson community. Since donations were less than previous years, it was necessary for GSCR to tap into our financial reserves to cover expenses The good news is that there was a 4% reduction in expenses from the prior year. GSCR station personnel and board members are taking measures to mitigate further losses, such as implementing cost reductions and additional fundraising activities.


